







# Discipline Committee 2014-15




3. Further, the Committee has taken steps to:


a. Information relating to Ragging and its impact were displayed on the <sup>College</sup> Notice Board.

5. As per the Anti-Ragging/UGC-SWRO/2016 3rd Amendment in UGC Regulations Dt. 26-10-2016, we have informed to students and parents about expanding per view of Ragging: which says as follows: Any act of physical or mental abuse targeted to another student on the ground of Colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional or origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background.



Understanding the seriousness of the menace of the Ragging Activities of students level, we are honestly doing our best to implement the measures suggested in the UGC Circulars issued in respect of curbing the menace of Ragging. 


The institution tries to implement





The institution tries to curb the menace of Ragging through the Discipline Committee and through the <sup>by</sup> appointing the class mentors.
