ACTION TAKEN REPORT DURING 2014-15

The plan of action was chalked out by IQAC in the beginning of the academic year 2014-15 towards the quality enhancement of the institution.

1. Preparation of Calendar of Events :

Along with the notified calendar of events of the university, the schedule (2014-15) of institutional programmes and functions were incorporated. The same was notified to all for advance preparation.

2. Organization / Conduct of Seminars :

- a. On 31.07.2014 One day UGC sponsored State Level Seminar was organized on “Kannada Nadige Christ Missionarigala Koduge” by the Department of Kannada.
- b. On 2nd and 3rd August 2014 two days UGC sponsored National Level Seminar was organized on “Hindi our Kannada Ke Adhunika Kavyame Dharm, Sanskriti Ka Darshan” by the Department of Hindi.
- c. On 8th and 9th August 2014 two days UGC sponsored National Level Seminar was organized on “Swami Vivekanand as a World Citizen” by the Department of Economics.

3. Conduct of Orientation Programmes and Special Lectures :

One day Orientation Programme was conducted on 11-08-2014 on “Swadeshi Vidyan Andolana” to our science students by the Department of Physics.

4. Jeevan Darshan Program :

Shri Shankargouda Biradar, a life member of Swadeshi Andolana and Social Activist has addressed our students on 22-08-2014 in the Jeevan Darshan Program of our college. He gave call to the students to practice human values of great thinkers along with getting the degree certificate.

7. Conduct of Inter Collegiate Speech Competition :

Under the joint auspicious of the Dept. of Karnataka Science and Technology, Bangalore and State Vignana Parishat, Bangalore the District Science Academy, an inter collegiate speech competition was held on 11-02-2015 in our college on the topic, “The Importance of Science in the development of the nation”.

8. Submission of Proposal for college with potential excellence (CPE) to the UGC :

It is under the direction of the IQAC chair person and in consultation with the senior faculty member, the proposal for college with potential excellence has been submitted to UGC for its financial assistance in the prescribed format. The above proposal has been forwarded through CDC, VSKU, Bellary.

9. National Science Day Celebration :

On the eve of National Science Day celebration to commemorate, Dr.C.V.Raman, Nobel Prize Winner, a science day function was organized by the Science Association of our college on 28-02-2015 at the seminar hall. Prof. B.D.Keshvan, HOD Physics, Prof. M.S.Dadmi, HOD Chemistry has addressed to our students about the achievements of Sir.C.V.Raman. They pointed out that Sir.C.V.Raman has made the country to feel proud by receiving Nobel Prize for his work on “Diffusion of Light” which paved the way for various inventions in physics.

Later both professors have interacted with students and answered their questions. In this function, science quiz competition and pick and speak competition was held for the science students and winners in the competition has been honoured with 1st and 2nd Prizes by the Principal. The IQAC Chairman Sri. S.L.Malipatil has presided over the function.

10.Valedictory Function of College Students Union of 2014-15 :

On 20th April 2015, valedictory function of the college students union 2014-15 and farewell to the final year students was organized in the function hall of our college. Sri. Sharat Hegade, a district Press Reporter of Deccan Herald, was invited to address to our out going students.

On this occasion, two Rank Holders of our college viz Kum. Sajal Jain(IInd Rank) and Kum. Varsha (IVth Rank) both B.Com Students were felicitated. In addition, the various cash prizes were given away to the meritorious students of BA, BCOM and BSC final year of 2013-14 which were instituted by the local philanthropists and retired professor of our college.

11.Extension Activities :

Our college provides the ample scope for promoting the participation of students and faculty in extension activities in and around the college campus. The NSS Unit (A&B) of our college has taken up several extension-extra-curricular activities in the college campus and at the different places regularly. The bench mark NSS activities are relating to prote the awareness of Hygiene and Sanitation, Tree Plantation, Protection of Environment. Further in collaboration with District Health Office, Koppal, our NSS volunteers have participated in pulse-polio, Aids prevention, Ban of

Tobacco, Blood Donation Camps, College level camps, National Integration Camps as well. During 2014-15, NSS special camp was organized in the Ojanahalli village of Koppal Taluka from 12-04-2015 to 18-04-2015. Participation in the shramadan activities in and around the Ojanahalli village – nearly primary school, anganawadi and temples. Along with the shramadan activities in the camp, daily special lectures were arranged in evening for our NSS volunteers and public in general. The annual NSS special camp was successful due to well planning by NSS co-ordinator proper direction of the Principal and active participation of NSS volunteers and co-operation of the local village leaders.

12. Conduct of UGC Sponsored Seminar in our College :

During 2014-15, three UGC sponsored seminars were sanctioned to our college. They are, Kannada, Hindi and Economics department. Out of these three seminars, one seminar of Kannada Department was State Level and other two are (Hindi and Economic Departments) were of National Level.

1. Department of Kannada :

State Level UGC sponsored seminar was organized on 31st July 2014 by the department of kannada of our college on the topic “Kannada Naadige Christ Missionarigala Koduge”. The prime aim of this state level seminar is to understand the plans and contributions made by the Christ Missionaries to the Karnataka in the field like education, social, literature, health and press during pre-independence period. During the pre-independence in India, education was privilege of upper caste and people of low caste and common people were not having the opportunity

to get the education. But it is the Christ missionaries who after coming over to Karnataka, have tried their best to universalize the education and health facilities in Karnataka. Further, the aim of the seminar was to know about how the individual Christ missionaries like E.P.Rice, B.L.Rice, Kittel, Hermon Mogale and others have contributed to the Kannada literature especially to Kannada inscriptions, folk songs, folk tales, traditional knowledge and medicine etc., the Contribution of Christ missionaries was very significant towards the propagating the local kannada language, local writers and local re-writers. The response to the seminar from the delegates, participants, students and public was very good. Hence the purpose of the seminar was successful in its objective.

2. Department of Hindi :

Two days national level UGC sponsored seminar was organized on 2nd and 3rd August 2014 by the department of Hindi of our college on the topic “Hindi Aur Kannadake Aadhunik Kavya me Dharm, Sanskriti Darshan”. The prime theme of seminar was to know about how our traditional Dharm, Sanskriti, Darshan has been expressed in the modern and Hindi and Kannada Kavya. Further, the aim of the seminar is to bring connecting link between two languages particularly, national language with regional language. The response towards seminar from the delegates, participants, students and public was very good. The students were much benefitted in understanding about the national poets in both the language. The seminar also benefitted to students in making the translation of literature in both the language.

3. Department of Economics :

In the auspicious occasion to commemorate 150th Birth Anniversary of Sri. Swami Vivekanand, the Department of Economics of our college has organized the UGC Sponsored two days National Level seminar on “Swami Vivekanand as a world citizen” on 8th and 9th August 2014 at the function hall.

The prime theme of the seminar was to disseminate Sri. Swami Vivekanand’s life and message which could be best inspiration for us today. The participants in this seminar have inspired by the eminent lectures on Swamiji thoughts and works which will definitely help them to mould their way of thinking and the perception about religion, humanity, selfless service, spiritualism, universal values, character building and education. The total theme of the seminar was to understand how and why Swamy Vivekanand has been still considered as a World Citizen. The response of the delegates, participants and students in this seminar was good and positive.
