In such situation, judges have stressed that **all women of this country should have legal awareness to claim their rights and thereby she can get gender justice in the society at all levels: social, economic and politically.** 

The gender justice programme was useful to our students which created the importance of legal awareness tour students especially to girls' students in their various stages of life from birth to death.

On 7-3-2017, under the joint auspicious by this committee and District Legal Authority of Koppal has **organized workshop on Constitutional Fundamental Rights and duties**. In this programme, District judge, Smt. Vijayalakshmi said that every citizen of this country before claiming his or fundamental rights, must know better the duties to be performed. Another judge on this occasion

Sri Dasharatha stressed that on one's own duties to be followed just like our freedom fighter and our Jawaaans have performed for this country. He gives various examples of duties to be performed honestly such as voters should vote honestly and pay tax, protect environment and create awareness about RTI & RTE root out the corruption from administration. And all citizens of this country conscious about duties and perform honestly and unitedly for peaceful progress of the nation.

On 11<sup>th</sup> October 2018, on the eve of international girl child day, Special awareness lecture programme was organized under the collaboration of District legal Authority of Koppal and our college. In this programme, District Judge, Srinivasan recalled the significance of this day all over the world and particularly in India. He told to our students that unless women understand their rights, and raises her voice and demand for facilities, the protection and facilities go in vain. Hence all he stressed that to have thought process on every harassment takes place against women and demand for their rights through proper channel. He further told that the mindset of male dominated society must change towards the girl's child that it is liable to the family. He said that women are eligible for equal rights and equal protection should be to them.

On the eve of International women's Day, the special lecture programme was organized on 8<sup>th</sup> March 2018 to create awareness about gender justice and equality concept among our student.

In this Prog. Smt. Sandhya Madinoor, Senior Advocate Koppal was invited to address to students. In her motivating speech she reminded that so far Indian women are performing multi-tasks in the family. And now onwards, it should be shared by male counter parts in the family; because gender discrimination begins at home. # Women Empowerment in support of Gender Equity (Self Employment Training)

### Background of the study

Handicrafts are those objects, which require skill with hands, or in other words, they are man-made. Basically, a product solely made by human hands without using any kind of complicated machinery or equipment is called handicraft. A simple dictionary meaning of handicraft is "an art or craft needing skill with the hands". It is the practice of making decorative of functional objects, wholly or partly by hand, and requiring both manual and artistic skill.

Handicraft activity is predominantly carried out in the unorganized household sector. Handicraft artisans/ manufacturers are household members practicing handicrafts activity jointly at their residence, who if need arises employ other handicraft artisans for work. In many regions of the world, handicrafts sector has been identified as the second largest sector of rural employment after agriculture.

Now towards the end of the Eleventh Plan, the Planning Commission is in process of formulating the Twelfth plan. In line with the 12th Plan objective to achieve faster, more inclusive and sustainable growth, the strategy under the 12th Plan for the Handicrafts sector aims at creating world class globally competitive environment, providing sustainable livelihood opportunities to the artisans and thereby resulting in balanced socio-economic development and inclusive growth

Objectives

- 1. To create self employment.
- 2. To earn money at home themselves by making handicrafts.
- 3. To enhance financial and economic position.
- 4. It creates skills in students by hand made products

### Report on Handicraft Training Programme for girls.

The college was organized the Programme for 7 days to empower the girls by making hand made products and Sarojahand made manufacturer at Gadaga, who is a entrepreneur and supply the goods to various places and earned monthly Rs.one lakh. she gave training to our students for a one week. It increases the earning of money at home, creative skills and financial and economic position of girls in future. **Shri Mallikarjun R Madival, Civil Judge Distict High Court** in his interactive brain storming session with the students provided various statistics of Koppal relating to child marriage, femal infanticide, gender discrimination, dowry harassment, employment reservations, sucide, sexual harassmentetc., and brought legal awarenessand provision of free legal aid and advice to the eligible persons; and make use POSCO's act of 2012, and other helplines. thereby providing justice to the people speedily .The mindset that a girl child is a liability needs to be changed and this requires happening at grass root level. Gone are the days, thatwomens need not be strive for equal rights alone but they are being protected from every small issue .

Another notableguest Public Prosecuter, Smt. Gowramma Desai shared her professional experiences that spelt there are equal problems from both the genders have equal rights, although womens is privileged with several legal rights still she is unable to make proper use of them only because of lack of confidence to fight till end, or simply file the petition with incomplete knowledge and return the cases in the middle. It is duty of every women to mentally remain strong mentally to organize and avoid silly reasons. She should understand and manage her families and society with proper decision making. She also requested our students to make proper use of electronic devices and not let them become slaves of those social media.She introduced girls about **POSCO e-box**, **1098**(Child abuse hotline), **1091** Women in Distress, 1800-3000-780 Mann Ki Baat on the toll-free number, 181 Domestic abuse and sexual violence-Women's Helpline, Nirbhaya App etc., Thousands of women are sharing personal stories of sexual harassment under the hashtag or title 'MeToo. Campaign etc., were the points of discussion.

Around 220students were benefited with this legal Awareness Program.Students were encouraged for interaction **Miss priyanka** from B A 1<sup>st</sup>sem hailing from Shimoga, Malnad raised her question on insecurities for women to move indepdently about sexual harassment and even murders in those regions from where she was born and brough up. **Kum.Indramma** from B A 5<sup>th</sup>Sem demanded that programs of this kind are the need of the hour and shared her

awareness on this kind of programme. **Miss Anu** from Bcom 3rd sem also shared that although this kind of any harassment did not occure while moving around they do have awareness of Nirbhaya and 109 etc., as educated them in various previous programmes organized. **Swathi from B Sc 3**<sup>rd</sup>sem shared with others how she helped her friend by calling through women and child helpline 1098 to stop the child Marriage of her friend.
